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| M | 665 | Hezekiah ⁸ , b. About 1810, perhaps Perrineville, Monmouth Co., NJ. Married his cousin Elizabeth ⁸ Chamberlin [LN 604], 10 Dec 1833, probably Middlesex Co., NJ. Died 1859, Carlisle, OH. + |
| F | 667 | Mary ⁸ , b. About 1811, probably Perrineville, Monmouth Co., NJ. Probably unmarried and living at home in 1850, aged 40 years. Nothing further known. |
| M | 666 | Ezekiel J ⁸ , b. 7 Feb 1813, Perrineville, Monmouth Co., NJ. Married (1) Ellen Kirby, about 1834 (?), probably Monmouth Co., NJ; (2) Mary Ann Kirby, 10 Feb 1837, Monmouth Co., NJ. Died 11 Apr 1884, Millstone Twp., Monmouth Co., NJ. + |
| M | 669 | John ⁸ , b. About 1824, probably Perrineville, Monmouth Co., NJ. Married Maria Riggs, about 1846, perhaps OH. In 1895, they were living at Carlisle, OH. + |
| M | 668 | William ⁸ , b. About 1825, probably Perrineville, Monmouth Co., NJ. Living at home in 1850. Nothing further known. |

BIOGRAPHICAL

According to Cummings, they removed to Ohio about 1847, where they lived in Carlisle, Warren County. They were both dead in 1895. Cummings also infers that there were children other than those listed here.

In 1830, he was probably the John Chamberlin living at Upper Freehold Twp., Monmouth Co., NJ, aged 40-50 years, heading a family of 0112001-1110001. In 1840, he is probably the John Chamberlin living next door to his son Hezekiah in Cherry Creek, Chautauqua Co., NY, heading a family of 00010001-00011001.

John is probably the “J. Chamberlin” heading the family that was enumerated in the 1850 census as follows: Cherry Creek, Chautauqua Co., NY, #1702/1761, 3 Sep 1850, P. 127:
