- M i Dell Martin Dibble, b. 7 Dec 1912, Grand Rapids, Kent Co., MI. Unmarried. He was a 2nd Lt. in the Army during the second world war. On July 29, 1944, he commanded a platoon of the 41st Armored Division at a crossroads 2_ miles southwest of Notre Dame de Cinilla in France. This platoon defeated a heavy German attack in hand-to-hand fighting. Although he was seriously wounded, he refused to leave his command, manned a machine gun and remained in action until the battle was won. He was subsequently awarded the Silver Star. After the war he was an electrical engineer and worked for a sorting company in South America. While on duty there, near Bogota, Colombia, SA, he was accidentally killed on 20 Jan 1948, and was buried there.
- M ii Dorothy Dibble, b. 23 Oct 1917, Grand Rapids, Kent Co., MI. She was a secretary in the police department.
