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| M | 7251 | James Thwing ⁸ , b. About 1827, perhaps Woolwich, Lincoln Co., ME. Married Caroline Elizabeth Emery, about 1854 (?), probably Bangor, ME. Died in 1861, Red Wing, MN. + |
| M | 7252 | Edmund ⁸ , b. About 1828, probably Bangor, Penobscot Co., ME. At the time of the 1850 census, he was living at home, aged 22 years; occupation a tailor. Enlisted in the Union Army during the Civil War and died in service. |
| F | 7253 | Angeline ⁸ , b. About 1829, probably Bangor, Penobscot Co., ME. At the time of the 1850 census, she was living at home, aged 21 years. |
| M | 7254 | Henry ⁸ , b. About 1831 (?), probably Bangor, Penobscot Co., ME. <i>The History of Embden, ME</i> , 1929, says he owned a ranch in northern CA. |
| M | 7255 | William ⁸ , b. About 1833 (?), probably Bangor, Penobscot Co., ME. Enlisted in the Union Army during the Civil War and died in service. |
| M | 7256 | Edward B ⁸ , b. About 1835, probably Bangor, Penobscot Co., ME. At the time of the 1850 census, he was living at home, aged 15 years. |
| M | 10821 | Joseph Watson ⁸ , b. About 1838, probably Bangor, Penobscot Co., ME. Married —?—, and had issue. In 1875, he was living at Cambridge, MA. + |

M 10822 Willis C⁸, b. About 1841, probably Bangor, Penobscot Co., ME. At the time of the 1850 census, he was living at home, aged 9 years.

BIOGRAPHICAL

He was born at Seven Mile Brook but the birth was recorded at Norridgewock, ME.

Ira joined the church (at woolwich ?) in 1819. In 1828, he settled in Bangor, ME.

The Chm Assoc mss gives the place of their marriage as Woodstock, ME. However, I can find no town by that name in Maine. *The History of Embden, Maine*, gives the place of their marriage as Woolwich (then in Lincoln Co.), ME.
