CHILDREN

- F 7257 Evelyn Augusta⁸, b. 10 Sep 1837, Solon, Kennebec Co., ME. Married Samuel D. Shipley, 15 July 1854, Lowell, MA. He was b. 23 Sep 1828; d. 16 June 1894, Brighton (now part of Boston), MA; buried at Lowell, MA. She died 14 June 1906, Seattle, WA. Their son, Frank Chamberlain Shipley, of Seattle, WA, and Los Angeles, CA, was a member of the old Chamberlain Association of America.
- M 7258 Alfred Mellen⁸, b. 12 Feb 1839, Moscow, Somerset Co., ME. Married Eva Marcella McConnell, 2 Mar 1871, San Francisco, CA. Died 12 Oct 1925, Seattle, WA. +
- M 7259 Charles C⁸, b. 26 Dec 1844, Solon, Kennebec Co., ME. Enlisted in the Union Army, Company C, 30th Massachusetts Infantry, and served in the Civil War. Probably unmarried. Died 1889, San Francisco, CA.
- F 7260 Emma A⁸, b. About 1848, Lowell, Middlesex Co., MA. "Ida ?"The Chamberlain Assoc mss gives a child Ida born in 1850, and says she married William Smith. No mention is made of the child Emma as listed in the 1850 census. I am assuming Ida and Emma are one and the same. However, there could be another daughter. Check the vital records.

BIOGRAPHICAL

He was living at home in 1818, when his father applied for a pension.

In 1840, Moses Chamberlain was living in Moscow, Somerset Co., ME, heading a family of 100001-10001 (1 male under the age of 5 years, 1 male between the ages of 30 and 40 years, 1 female under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 20 and 30 years). One person employed in Agriculture.

In 1840, Moses was living in Ward 5, Lowell, Middlesex Co., MA. Dwelling No. 584, Family No. 855. 23 Aug 1850, as follows:
