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| M | 7261 | Henry C ⁸ , b. About 1837 (?), Solon, Somerset Co., ME. Married Emily Watson and resided at Sheboygan Falls, WI. Served in the Union Army and was killed at the Battle of Nashville, Tennessee, in Dec 1864. |
| F | 7262 | Miranda ⁸ , b. About 1841 (?), probably Solon, Somerset Co., ME. Died young, probably before 1850. |
| M | 7263 | Albert C ⁸ , b. About 1843, Brighton, Somerset Co., ME. Married Belle Hodge and resided at Sheboygan, WI. |
| M | 7264 | Luther Milton ⁸ , b. About 1845, Brighton, Somerset Co., ME. Married Mary Elizabeth Lansing, — Jan 1873, Ottawa, IL. In 1891, they were living at Ottawa, IL. + |

BIOGRAPHICAL

Samantha Townsend was of Canaan, NH, at the time of their marriage.

Aaron Chamberlain was an undertaker, and also engaged in the furniture business. He is listed in the 1840 census, at Brighton, ME, heading a family of 10001-10001.

This family was enumerated in the 1850 census as follows: Lowell, Ward 5, Middlesex Co., MA, #549/818, 22 Aug 1850, P. 149:

How long they remained at Lowell is not known, but he later removed to Wisconsin. A relative, Charles W. Chamberlin, says that Aaron lived for a time in Sheboygan, WI.
