He resided at Brattleboro, VT, where he served as Chairman of the Board of Auditors on the board of assessors, and was an accountant, etc. He was one of the trustees of the Baptist church. As a member of the old Chamberlain Association of America, he contributed much to the compilation of the descendants of Thomas¹ of Woburn. He was a trustee of the Austine Institute for the Deaf and Blind and at one time was employed by the Board of Health in compiling the state vital statistics.
