- M i Thomas Davis, b. 4 Nov 1718 (1715 ?), Roxbury, Suffolk Co., MA. "Deacon." Married, as her second husband, Dorothy Child. She was the daughter of John & Abigail (Aspinwall) Child. Her father, John Child, was a brother of Hannah Child who married John Chamberlin [LN 7593], a first cousin of her mother (*Parker-Ruggles Genealogy*). Thomas Davis died 1 Aug 1778, Oxford, MA.
- M ii Daniel Davis. He was of Oxford, MA.
- M iii Elisha Davis, b. 1722. He was a Captain of the Militia. Married Mary Harris, 1751. She was the daughter of Timothy & Mary (Stearns) Harris, b. 1717; d. 1796. He died in 1796.
- M iv Edward Davis. Married Abigail Learned.

BIOGRAPHICAL

Mary was a twin of her brother John.

Samuel Davis removed to Oxford, MA, in 1729, where he was a selectman, representative and Deacon for 25 years. They had twelve children according to the *History of Oxford, MA*.

Mary's granddaughter Louisa Davis married Perley Howe, and their great great granddaughter Louisa Marvin Howe, of Indianapolis, Indiana, joined the Chamberlain Association of America in 1914.

Samuel Davis's second wife, Mary Weld, was a daughter of Joseph & Sarah (Faxon) Weld, and a step-sister of his first wife Mary Chamberlain.
