M 7631 John⁴, b. 28 Oct 1730, Roxbury, Suffolk Co., MA. Married Sarah Trott, 24 Mar 1768, Roxbury, MA. Died 8 Feb 1794, Roxbury, MA. +

F 7632 Hannah⁴, b. 12 Oct 1732, Roxbury, Suffolk Co., MA. Baptized 29 Oct 1732. Married Nathaniel⁴ Parker (or Nehemiah Parker, according to Prentiss Glazier), 1 Jan 1756, Roxbury, MA. He was the son of Timothy³ [Nathaniel², Thomas¹] & Keziah (—?—) Parker, b. about 1732, Hopkinton, MA; d. 15 Jan 1774, Holliston, MA, "aged 42 years." Seven children. She died in May 1813.

F 7633 Katherine⁴, b. 3 or 5 Oct 1735, Roxbury, Suffolk Co., MA. Baptized 12 Oct 1735, West Roxbury church. Married John Weld Jr., 1 Jan 1754, Trinity Church, Boston, MA. He was of Roxbury, MA.

BIOGRAPHICAL

He was a twin of his sister Mary. The *Griffith Bowen Genealogy* says she was born in Framingham, MA. The *Parker-Ruggles Genealogy* thinks his age of 92 at death is in error. Should be 89 years.

Prentiss Glazier says all three children were baptized at West Roxbury, MA.

No issue by his first wife.

Is the mother of Hannah Bowen, Hannah Winchester or Hannah Wincester? And, was Hannah born in 1704 rather than 1702?

On 7 May 1739, in partnership with Edward Tooker and Samuel White, also of Roxbury, he purchased 62 acres of land in Dudley, MA. Of Roxbury, he joined with his brother Jacob on 20 Apr 1743 and 2 Jan 1743/44, in sales of land at Woodstock. On 6 Mar 1744, they sold 23_ acres of land in the first division of lots in the North or —?— half of Woodstock (*Woodstock, CT, Deeds*, Liber 2, P. 315).
