BIOGRAPHICAL

Stephen is not found in the 1790 census, when he was probably living with his parents or another family.

In 1800, Stephen Chamberlain Jr. was living in Roxbury, Norfolk Co., MA, heading a family of 2001-1001 (2 males under the age of 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 26 and 45 years, 1 female under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 26 and 45 years).

In 1810, Stephen Chamberlain was again living in Roxbury, Norfolk Co., MA, heading a family of 0201-2101 (2 males between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 male between the ages of 26 and 45 years, 2 females under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 female between the ages of 26 and 45 years).

In 1820, Stephen Chamberlain was living in Roxbury, Norfolk Co., MA, heading a family of 000111-01001 (1 male between the ages of 18 and 26 years, 1 male between the ages of 26 and 45 years, 1 male aged 45 years and upwards, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 female aged 45 years and upwards). Three persons engaged in Agriculture.

On 18 May 1823, a Stephen Chamberlain, Jr., of Roxbury, was married to Mary Ann Morse, of Dorchester, by Dr. John Codman (*Boston Record of Commissioners*, Vol. 21, P. 348). This must refer to a younger Stephen, probably a son of the Stephen of this record.

In 1830, Stephen Chamberlain was living in Roxbury, Norfolk Co., MA, heading a family of 000000001-000000001 (1 male between the ages of 60 and 70 years, 1 female between the ages of 50 and 60 years).

Lois Bowker was of Sudbury, MA, and Richard Bonney says she was born there, but gives no further details.
