She was the daughter of Ezekiel & Susan (—?—) Wellington, b. Ashby, MA; d. —?—. He married (2) Mrs. Lora M. Whitman, 8 Oct 1885, Gorham, NH. She was a music teacher at Worcester, MA.
- M 8070 Alvin⁶, b. 2 Oct 1821, Woodstock, Windham Co., CT. He was admitted to the church in Woodstock, CT, 30 Apr 1836.

BIOGRAPHICAL

On 23 Jan 1802, his father Abiel Chamberlain, conveyed to “my son Abiel Chamberlain, for £100, land on the north half of Woodstock with a mansion house and barn,” property purchased of Asa Child in 1784.

On 8 Nov 1832, he and his wife joined the North Church in Woodstock.

On 17 Oct 1846, Salome Chamberlain and Samuel Chamberlain, both of Woodstock, CT, gave bond to administer the estate of Abiel Chamberlain. At his death, Abiel owned 35 acres of land “with buildings thereon” (*Woodstock Probate Files*, State Library, Hartford, CT).

Not located in the 1800 or 1810 censuses when he was probably living with his parents. In 1820, he was of Woodstock, CT, aged 45 years and upwards, heading a family of 410001-12011. In 1830, again of Woodstock, he was aged 50-60 years with a family of 01200001-0001101. In 1840, still of Woodstock, aged 60-70 years, his family consisted of 000110001-00001101.
