- M 8079 William Ashley⁶, b. 2 Jan 1820, Woodstock, Windham Co., CT. Married Emma E. Bronson, 17 Nov 1847, perhaps Middlebury, CT. Died 19 Aug 1885, Plymouth, IL. +
- M 8080 Spencer⁶, b. 9 Sep 1823, Woodstock, Windham Co., CT. Unmarried. He lived at Petersburg, VA, where he died 14 Nov 1874, "aged 51 years." Buried at the East Woodstock Yard, where his name is on a gravestone.
- F 8081 Alice Eddy⁶, b. 24 July 1828, Woodstock, Windham Co., CT. The published vital records of Woodstock call her "Alcey E." Married Ezra Child May, 5 Feb 1851, probably Woodstock, CT. He was the son of Asa & Sally (—?—) May, b. 13 Oct 1825, Woodstock, CT; d. 26 Apr 1909, "aged 83 years, six months and 13 days." He was a town clerk at Woodstock. She died 29 Aug 1873, probably Woodstock, CT, "aged 45 years."

BIOGRAPHICAL

He was a miller at Woodstock, CT. Her father, Zephaniah Tucker, was a veteran of the Revolutionary War.

He and his wife were members of the North Church in Woodstock, CT.

Prentiss Glazier says he died 5 Mar 1853, “aged 70 years.”

Not located in the 1800 and 1810 censuses when he was probably living at home. In 1820, aged 26-44 years, he was living at Woodstock, CT, heading a family of 10001-1001. In 1830, again of Woodstock, aged 40-50 years, his family consisted of 0110001-1000001001. In 1840, he was still of Woodstock, aged 50-60 years, with a family of 00011001-00120002001.

This family was enumerated in the 1850 census as follows: Woodstock, Windham Co., CT, #358/411, 19 Sep 1850, P. 269:
