M 8082 Sewell⁶, b. About July 1800, probably Newport, Cheshire Co., NH. Died 7 Sep 1826, "aged 26 years and 2 months."

M 8083 Edmund⁶, b. 1 Sep 1802, Newport, Cheshire Co., NH. He received his A.B. from Middlebury College in 1826. He preached to the Baptist church at Marshfield, VT, before entering college and returned to it as pastor. According to the Catalogue of Middlebury College, Edmund died unmarried, 8 Sep 1826, Plainfield, VT. On 30 Nov 1826, Israel Goodwin was appointed administrator of his estate (*American Quarterly Register*, Vol. xii, P. 315).

In 1800, Ralph Chamberlin was living in Newport, Cheshire Co., NH, heading a family of 101-111 (1 male under the age of 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 16 and 26 years, 1 female under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 female between the ages of 16 and 26 years).

In 1810, Ralph Chamberlin was living in Hanover, Grafton Co., NH, heading a family of 2101-1012 (2 males under the age of 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 male between the ages of 26 and 45 years, 1 female under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 16 and 26 years, 2 females between the ages of 26 and 45 years).

In 1820, Ralph Chamberlin was living in Plainfield, Washington Co., VT, heading a family of 210001-1101 (2 males under the age of 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 male aged 45 years and upwards, 1 female under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 female between the ages of 26 and 45 years). One person engaged in Commerce.

Ralph was said to have owned a farm of 160 acres with two dwelling houses (Plainfield ?).

On 25 Sep 1826, Hial Chamberlain [who was he?], of Plainfield, VT, was appointed Administrator of the estate of Ralph Chamberlain.
