M 17123 Jason⁷ Chamberlain, b. About 1816, probably Marblehead, Essex Co., MA. In 1850, he was living at home aged 37 years.

M 17124 George⁷ Chamberlain, b. About 1823, probably Marblehead, Essex Co., MA. In 1850, he was living in Marblehead, MA.

BIOGRAPHICAL

This is a tentative record based almost entirely upon census records. Research needed to verify.

In 1810, Jason Chamberlain was living in Marblehead, Essex Co., MA, heading a family of 011-211 (1 male between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 male between the ages of 16 and 26 years, 2 females under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 female between the ages of 16 and 26 years).

In 1820, Jason Chamberlain was again living in Marblehead, Essex Co., MA, heading a family of 21001-1102 (2 males under the age of 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 male between the ages of 26 and 45 years, 1 female under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 2 females between the ages of 26 and 45 years). Two persons engaged in Manufactures.

In 1830, Jason Chamberlain was again still living in Marblehead, Essex Co., MA, heading a family of 0120001-111111 (1 male between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 2 males between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 40 and 50 years, 1 female under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 female between the ages of 15 and 20 years, 1 female between the ages of 20 and 30 years, 1 female between the ages of 30 and 40 years).

In 1840, Jason Chamberlain was again still living in Marblehead, Essex Co., MA, heading a family of 00012001-00021001 (1 male between the ages of 15 and 20 years, 2 males between the ages of 20 and 30 years, 1 male between the ages of 50 and 60 years, 2 females between the ages of 15 and 20 years, 1 female between the ages of 20 and 30 years, 1 female between the ages of 50 and 60 years).

In 1850, Jason was living in Marblehead, Essex Co., MA. Dwelling No. 150, Family No. 608, 8 Aug 1850, as follows:

The Ann Chamberlin in the foregoing record is probably the wife of Jason Jr., rather than a sister. The 1850 census record also supports the DAR record (as cited by Glazier) which says that Jason was born in Maine, rather than New Hampshire.

In a cryptic note, Glazier asks if Jason went to Marblehead, MA, and married Eleanor P. Stevens there in 1806. The referenced DAR record says he was born at Lebanon, ME.
