BIOGRAPHICAL

In 1809, Thomas was a Selectman of Brookfield, NH.

On 22 Oct 1838, Thomas Chamberlain, of Brookfield, deposed on the pension application of Judith Chamberlain, widow of Thomas, in which he stated that he was 54 years old and a nephew of Judith's deceased husband, Thomas. It seems most likely that the Thomas of this record was either a son of William⁵ [LN 8728] or a son of James⁵ [LN 8730], but it seems the best choice is James.

Thomas is not found in the 1820 census because most of the Strafford county schedules have been lost.

In 1830, Thomas Chamberlain was living in Brookfield, Strafford Co., NH, heading a family of 1010001-100101 (1 male under the age of 5 years, 1 male between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 40 and 50 years, 1 female under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 15 and 20 years, 1 female between the ages of 30 and 40 years). Thomas⁶ Chamberlain (No. 9114) – Continued

In 1840, Thomas Chamberlain was again living in Brookfield, Strafford Co., NH, heading a family of 00100001-1010001 (1 male between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 50 and 60 years, 1 female under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 female between the ages of 40 and 50 years). One person employed in Agriculture, one person employed as a Manufacturer and Trader.

In 1850, Thomas was living in Brookfield, Carroll Co., NH. Dwelling No. 39, Family No. 39, 23 Sep 1850, as follows:
