- M 16701 James Brackett⁷, b. 16 Oct 1810, Lebanon, York Co., ME. Married (1) Almira B. Foss, June 1834, Lebanon, ME (widowed); probably (2) Lucena "Louissiana" Lord, 18 Nov 1855, Lebanon, ME. Died 29 Apr 1883, Lebanon, ME. +
- M 16702 Ira⁷, b. 16 Sep 1812, Lebanon, York Co., ME. In 1850, he may have been the Ira Chamberlain, aged 37 years, living in Bradford, Merrimack Co., NH, with a family, except his birth place is given as Vermont. Nothing further known.
- F 16703 Miranda⁷, b. 13 Mar 1815, Lebanon, York Co., ME. Married Samuel M. Flag (of Dover, NH), Int. 20 July 1836, Lebanon, ME.
- F 9648 Lydia⁷, b. 20 Oct 1817, Lebanon, York Co., ME. Married Lewis Chamberlain Blaisdell, 3 Sep 1837, Lebanon, ME. He was b. 1815; d. 1848. Lydia d. 1884. One daughter known: Ellen Elizabeth Blaisdell, b. 1843; m. James Francis Powers, 1863. He was b. 1837; d. 1873. They had daughter Laura Powers, b. Charlestown, MA; DAR 85739.
- M 16704 Lewis⁷, b. 14 Aug 1820, Lebanon, York Co., ME. A posthumous child. In 1850, he may have been the Lewis Chamberlin, aged 28 years, living alone in Dover, Strafford Co., NH. Nothing further known.

BIOGRAPHICAL

In 1810, Lewis Chamberlain was living in Lebanon, York Co., ME, heading a family of 011-001 (1 male between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 male between the ages of 16 and 26 years, 1 female between the ages of 16 and 26 years).

In 1820, Lydia Chamberlin, then a widow, was living in Lebanon, York Co., ME, heading a family of 21-2001 (2 males under the age of 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 2 females under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 26 and 45 years). "Mrs Lydia."

In 1830, Lydia Chamberlain, still a widow, was living in Lebanon, York Co., ME, heading a family of 0011-0011001 (1 male between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 15 and 20 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 female between the ages of 15 and 20 years, 1 female between the ages of 40 and 50 years). "Mrs. Lydia."

In 1840, Lydia was probably living with one of her children. In 1850, aged 60 years, Lydia was living with her son James Brackett Chamberlain. See 1850 census, Lebanon, ME.

He was "killed in his mill" says the Lebanon death record. His title then was "Captain."
