In 1800, James Chamberlain was living in Raynham, Bristol Co., MA, heading a family of 00013-0001 (1 male between the ages of 26 and 45 years, 3 males aged 45 years and upwards, 1 female between the ages of 26 and 45 years). Recheck this record; the age groups are completely off.

In 1810, James Chamberlane was living in Raynham, Bristol Co., MA, heading a family of 2001-2211 (2 males under the age of 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 26 and 45 years, 2 females under the age of 10 years, 2 females between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 female between the ages of 16 and 26 years, 1 female between the ages of 26 and 45 years). "Jas."

In 1820, he was probably the James Chamberlain who was living in Franklin, Norfolk Co., MA, heading a family of 100001-01001 (1 male under the age of 10 years, 1 male aged 45 years and upwards, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 16 years, 1 female aged 45 years and upwards). One person engaged in Agriculture, one in Manufactures.

In 1830, he was probably the James Chamberlain who was living in Bellingham, Norfolk Co., MA, heading a family of 22000101-01000101 (2 males under the age of 5 years, 2 males between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 30 and 40 years, 1 male between the ages of 50 and 60 years, 1 female between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 30 and 40 years, 1 female between the ages of 50 and 60 years).

He died of "Inward cancer." Did he die in Rhode Island?

For a time he lived at the Almshouse in Plympton, MA.
