BIOGRAPHICAL

In 1895, Mary was living at Toms River, NJ, and unmarried. She either was married about 1854 and then divorced or widowed before 1860, when she was listed in the 1860 census, as Mary Chamberlin, a servant in the household of Richard Chamberlin, probably her father, aged 25 years and a servant.

This record calling her Mary Chamberlin throws doubt upon her supposed marriage to Mr. Thompson.
