BIOGRAPHICAL

On 23 Aug 1828, a James Chamberlain, of Richland Co., OH, executed a Power of Attorney & Title bond document in which he, James Chamberlain, sold to Josiah Chamberlain, a fourth part of 148 acres in Harrison County, “occupied by John Chamberlain...deceased,” for the sum of \$250 to be paid in installments during 1829-1833. This document was recorded in Harrison County, VA, on 17 Aug 1829 (*Harrison County, Virginia, Deeds, Book 19, p. 342.*)

On 11 Apr 1829, Harrison Co., VA, the heirs-at-law of John Chamberlain Sr, deceased, were named as John Chamberlain, Josiah Chamberlain, Joseph Smith and wife Ann, “respecting the division of his landed estate...” On 14 Aug 1829, it was shown that Josiah Chamberlain had in actuality two shares to the estate, one his own, and the other purchased from his brother James Chamberlain, then of Richland Co., OH (*Harrison County, Virginia, Deeds, Book 19, pp. 385-86.*)

On 10 Sep 1836, James Chamberlain and his wife Sarah, deposed that they had received \$250 from Josiah Chamberlain, “for land on Booth’s Creek, Harrison Co., VA, occupied formerly occupied by John Chamberlain, deceased....” This deposition was recorded in Harrison County, VA, on 20 Oct 1836 (*Harrison County, Virginia, Deeds, Book 25, P. 130*). James’ wife Sarah was interviewed apart from her husband to verify final settlement “without the threats...of her husband.”

James Chamberlain removed to Ohio as a young man before 1830.

In 1830, James Chamberlain was living in Clear Creek Twp, Richland Co., OH, heading a family of 200001-10001 (2 males under the age of 5 years, 1 male between the ages of 30 and 40 years, 1 female under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 20 and 30 years).

In 1840, James Chambelain was living in Clear Creek Twp, Richland Co., OH, heading a family of 2120001-101001 (2 males under the age of 5 years, 1 male between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 2 males between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 40 and 50 years, 1 female under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 female between the ages of 30 and 40 years). One person employed in Agriculture.

In 1850, James and family were living in Clear Creek Twp, Ashland Co., OH. Dwelling No. 23, Family No. 23, 16 Sep 1850, as follows:

The John Chamberlin in the foregoing census record is James' brother, and the John Jr. is presumed to be John's son. This record also infers that John's wife was dead by this time.

In 1860, John & family were again living in Clear Creek, Ashland Co., OH. Dwelling No. 1105, Family No. 1142. Ashland Post Office, 7 Aug 1860, as follows:

In Dec. 1826 James purchased from Wm. McCorkle, 110 acres S.E. quarter, section 25, Clearcreek Township.

Exact place of his residence is not clear from the available records. Ashland County was created in 1846 from Wayne County. Perhaps Clear Creek Township originally lay in both Richland and Wayne counties. This township is listed as two words in the 1850 census, though it is presently one word.

The information supplied by Gladys Estella Chamberlain, in Nov 1930, gives his date of birth as 8 Jan 1797.
