M 17490 John⁹ Chamberlain, b. About 1830, perhaps Ashland Co., OH. He and his father were living with his uncle James Chamberlin and family in 1850, when his age was given as 20.

BIOGRAPHICAL

John was said to have married Mary Nay, probably Harrison Co., VA.

In 1820, he was probably the John *Chambrlin* living in Harrison Co., VA, heading a family of 0001-001 (1 male between the ages of 18 and 26 years, 1 female between the ages of 16 and 26 years). One person engaged in Agriculture.

In 1830, John Chamberlin was living in Eastern District, Harrison Co., VA, heading a family of 100001-21001 (1 male under the age of 5 years, 1 male between the ages of 30 and 40 years, 2 females under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 20 and 30 years). Second female age group uncertain.

In 1840, John Chamberlain was again living in Harrison Co., VA, heading a family of 0010001-1112001 (1 male between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 40 and 50 years, 1 female under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 2 females between the ages of 15 and 20 years, 1 female between the ages of 40 and 50 years). Two persons employed in Agriculture.

In 1850, John and his son John, were living with his brother James (see his record, LN11645) and family in Clear Creek Twp., Ashland Co., OH, indicating that he was probably widowed and the rest of his children grown and gone.
