BIOGRAPHICAL

On 23 Aug 1828, James Chamberlain, of Richland Co., OH, executed a Power of Attorney & Title bond document in which he, James Chamberlain, sold to Josiah Chamberlain, a fourth part of 148 acres in Harrison County, “occupied by John Chamberlain...deceased,” for the sum of \$250 to be paid in installments during 1829-1833. This document was recorded in Harrison County, VA, on 17 Aug 1829 (*Harrison County, Virginia, Deeds, Book 19, p. 342*).

On 11 Apr 1829, Harrison Co., VA, the heirs-at-law of John Chamberlain Sr, deceased, were named as John Chamberlain, Josiah Chamberlain, Joseph Smith and wife Ann, “respecting the division of his landed estate...” On 14 Aug 1829, it was shown that Josiah Chamberlain had in actuality two shares to the estate, one his own, and the other purchased from his brother James Chamberlain, then of Richland Co., OH (*Harrison County, Virginia, Deeds, Book 19, pp. 385-86*).

On 10 Sep 1836, James Chamberlain and his wife Sarah, deposed that they had received \$250 from Josiah Chamberlain, “for land on Booth’s Creek, Harrison Co., VA, occupied formerly occupied by John Chamberlain, deceased...” This deposition was recorded in Harrison County, VA, on 20 Oct 1836 (*Harrison County, Virginia, Deeds, Book 25, P. 130*). James’ wife Sarah was interviewed apart from her husband to verify final settlement “without the threats...of her husband.”

In 1830, *Josias* Chamberlin was living in the Eastern District, Harrison Co., VA, heading a family of 20002-01000001 (2 males under the age of 5 years, 2 males between the ages of 20 and 30 years, 1 female between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 50 and 60 years).

In 1840, Josiah Chamberlain was living in Harrison Co., VA, heading a family of 311001-0111001 (3 males under the age of 5 years, 1 male between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 30 and 40 years, 1 female between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 female between the ages of 15 and 20 years, 1 female between the ages of 40 and 50 years). Two persons employed in Agriculture.

Josiah and his family emigrated to Illinois from Virginia about 1847-48.

In 1850, Josiah and family were living in Marshall Co., IL. Dwelling No. 2, Family No. 2, 12 Oct 1850, as follows:

Nearby in the town of Lacon, in the same county is John Chamberlin, aged 23, b. VA, a tanner, living with John A. Waterman, et al, Household #8 (enumerated 5 Sep 1850) who might be the son of Josiah's brother James.
