BIOGRAPHICAL

Both George's & Mary's birth dates are computed from their age at death. His wife Mary is buried next to him, but her inscription gives her age as 29 years, 11 months and 29 days. I believe this to be in error and probably should be 79 years, 11 months, and 29 days. The Columbiana county death records state that George was aged 84 years, 9 months, and 2 days, whereas the cemetery inscriptions give 81 years, 9 months, and 2 days. These records also confirm the information about Mary.

In 1820, he was probably the George Chamberlain who was living in Hanover, Washington Co., PA, heading a family of 10001-3001 (1 male under the age of 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 26 and 45 years, 3 females under the age of 10 years, 1 female between the ages of 26 and 45 years). One person engaged in Agriculture.

In 1830, George Chamberlane was again living in Hanover, Washington Co., PA, heading a family of 1110001-11201 (1 male under the age of 5 years, 1 male between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 1 male between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 40 and 50 years, 1 female under the age of 5 years, 1 female between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 2 females between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 female between the ages of 20 and 30 years).

By the terms of his fathers will in 1839, George was appointed Executor of his father's estate and given full authority to dispose of all property, real and personal.

In 1840, George Chamberlain was living in St. Clair Twp, Columbiana Co., OH, heading a family of 01201001-0000001 (1 male between the ages of 5 and 10 years, 2 males between the ages of 10 and 15 years, 1 male between the ages of 20 and 30 years, 1 male between the ages of 50 and 60 years, 1 female between the ages of 40 and 50 years). "Geo." One person employed in Agriculture. George's age is off a point in this census, when he was in fact, aged 50-60 years.

In 1850, George and family were living in St. Clair Twp, Columbiana Co., OH. Dwelling No. 1517, Family No. 1538, 6 Sep 1850, as follows:
